SAMMinistries TLLC – Meal Team and Childcare 4:30pm – 7:30pm

SAMMinistries' Transitional Living and Learning Center is home to families as they work to overcome homelessness. The TLLC provides housing, support and resources to families who show a commitment to gaining self-sufficiency. The individual needs of all family members are supported for a two-year period, promoting the viability of the family as a whole while they transition out of homelessness. Every Thursday night, adult residents attend Life Skill Classes that help them better transition to a life of independence. Classes include parenting, money management, health and wellness, job readiness, and more. *To encourage the residents to attend, we will provide and serve a meal to ~100 residents (including 50 children ages 18 and under). Dinner will be served from 5 - 6pm. SACS volunteers are invited to lead the TLLC children in outdoor activities to include sidewalk chalk, bubbles, soccer, basketball, and more from 6 - 7:30pm, while the adult residents attend class.* Facility address: 5922 Blanco Rd.
