

Tablet Information for the 2023-2024 School Year

Please read carefully.

Tablet Drop-off (no later than Friday, June 16th)

When you drop the tablet in the **Secondary Admin Office**, be sure to also **label and include** the following:

- Keyboard
- Digital Stylus
- · Tablet charger
- Case
- Tablet Setup Form (attached)

If the tablet has been previously used, please back up all files (including pictures) currently loaded on it as <u>everything will</u> <u>be removed during setup</u>. Again, be sure to save those things that are important to you to a cloud storage or to a flash drive.

We will notify you via your FACTS parent email when tablet configuration is complete.

Requirements

Minimum requirements for the program are:

- Microsoft Windows 11 operating system (Apple devices and Chromebooks do <u>not</u> qualify, nor does Surface Pro X *)
- Digital pen/stylus (<u>not</u> the "fat-tipped" capacitive type)
- Keyboard
- "Always-on" protective case

Recommended Devices and Specifications

- Recommended device with minimum suggested specifications
 - o Surface Pro 7 or later (Do not purchase a Surface Pro X* for school use)
 - o Minimum Intel Core i5 processor, 8GB RAM, 128GB SSD hard drive
 - o Surface Pro Type Cover keyboard (SPro 8 and 9 keyboards are different than for the 7)
 - o Microsoft Complete Accidental Damage Warranty (3 years minimum)
 - o Surface Pen (SPro 8 & 9 have differently shaped pens to store in the SP* Keyboard)
 - Any military drop certified case that will remain on the device while in use.
- Budget device** with minimum suggested specifications
 - o Surface Go 3 with Intel Core M3 processor, 8GB RAM, 128GB SSD hard drive
 - o Surface Go Type Cover keyboard
 - o Microsoft Complete Accidental Damage Warranty (3 years minimum)
 - o Surface Pen
 - o Any military drop certified case that will remain on the device while in use.

<u>THERE IS NO NEED TO PURCHASE OFFICE 365.</u> Microsoft Office 365, including the entire Microsoft Office productivity suite, is included at no cost to you for as long as your student is enrolled at SACS.

Additional Recommendations

After ten years in our 1-to-1 program, the Microsoft Surface Pro has proven to be reliable and to possess all the critical features necessary for our program. We believe that, if kept updated and properly cared for, this device should last our students a minimum of 4 years, probably longer.

We recommend purchasing your student's device via Microsoft online at: https://www.microsoft.com/en-us/store/b/education.

We highly recommend purchasing the Microsoft Complete Extended Warranty (minimum 3 years of coverage), since it covers manufacture defects <u>and</u> accidental damage (two full device replacements for the life of the warranty). This warranty <u>does not cover loss or theft</u>.

We also highly recommend an "Always-on," military drop-certified case, with stylus storage such as:

- Kensington Blackbelt
- Urban Armor Gear (UAG)

^{**} Please note that, while this device is on our Recommended List, its processor speed lags behind that of the i5 processor on the Surface Pro and could potentially cause frustration with high usage.
